



WORKING EQUITATION CANADA SHOW LICENSING

PLEASE FILL OUT AN APPLICATION FORM PER SHOW. EACH SHOW LICENSE REQUIRES A SEPARATE APPLICATION.

In order to receive approval of WECan show licensing the following requirements must be met:

- 1) There is a mandatory \$10 processing fee that is required to be submitted with EACH licensing application submitted to the WECan Events Committee.
- 2) Strict adherence to the rule book as published on the Working Equitation Canada website:
<http://workingequitationcanada.com/rules/> Refer to rule book for a full list of officials and trial requirements.
- 3) Judges must be licensed. A current list of Canadian judges and officials may be viewed at:
<http://workingequitationcanada.com/officials/> Other working Equitation association licensed judges are also acceptable if proof of licensing is available.
- 4) Compliance with Working Equitation Canada's membership requirements. Competitors must be individual or family membership holders to compete. Non-members will be allowed to compete at "B" rated shows for a non-member fee as outlined in the show licensing requirements and application. Reciprocity of membership requirements is being granted to members of international organizations that wish to compete at WECan licensed events and are members in good standing with one of their national working equitation representative bodies. Points awarded in WECan licensed events will be shared with the competitor's membership organization.
- 5) Horses must have a recording number in order to be eligible for lifetime achievement and year end high point awards. Members are entitled to a free one time horse recording number.



- 6) Working Equitation Canada Application for Show Licensing must be filled out in its entirety. For “B” rated shows the form must be received a minimum of 45 days prior to the date requested for the show. For all other shows, the form must be received 90 days prior to the requested date. Submitted licensing application forms must be accompanied by the show entry form and prize list.
- 7) Shows licensed by WECan must have minimum \$2,000,000.00 facility and event insurance, and WECan must be named as an additional insured. Proof of this insurance must be submitted to WECan at least 2 weeks prior to the start of the show. Failure to produce proof of insurance within this time frame will result in a \$100.00 penalty and the WECan Show Licensing Contract will be void due to breach of contract and removed from the show.
- 8) All competition results must be received by the WECan Events Committee no later than 2 weeks following the conclusion of the show. Final entrant fees for all WECan recorded horses that started competition at the show (\$2.00 per entry) and all non-member rider fees (\$25/rider) must be received by the WECan Events Committee no later than 2 weeks following the conclusion of the show. Results received after the allotted time will not count towards WECan awards or medals.
- 9) The show **MUST** advertise itself as a licensed WECan show in a clear statement and **MUST** include the current WECan logo on any prize list, print or digital advertisements. This may be added to the prize list after submission of the Application for Show Licensing but must be presented to WECan 30 days prior to the show.
- 10) WECan must be notified of any changes to the show dates, location, name or if the show has been cancelled.

WECan Application for Show Licensing may be submitted by e-mail to events@workingequitationcanada.com, print and fax to (403)601-8723 or may be submitted online at least 45 days prior to the start of the competition and must be accompanied by the show entry form and prize list.
